

COVID IN BELGIUM

To enable entry into Belgium and participation in the CNE International Cystinosis Conference 2022, all participants will have to comply with the requirements and measures in force at the time in the country of departure and arrival. It goes without saying that the requirements and measures change regularly over time. In case of a cancellation of the conference due to COVID we will reimburse the registration fee.

At the moment (updated June 2022) there are no testing or quarantine requirements for traveling into Belgium*. Wearing a face mask is no longer mandatory in Belgium, as of March 23rd 2022, except in hospitals*.

As you are aware, many people with cystinosis have had kidney transplants and will be immunosuppressed. We would ask that you keep this in mind. While mask wearing is not mandatory in Belgium as mentioned above, out of respect to people in our community who may feel safer, we welcome and recommend mask wearing while indoors at conference sessions.
