Photography policies

A professional photographer will be present on Thursday evening and Friday morning to take group photos of participants and families. During the conference, these photos will be visible on a **photo wall**, so that everyone can check who is present at the conference. At the end of the conference, participants can take their photo home.

Participants are allowed to take **collective shots** of the conference as long as they respect the privacy of other participants by not taking photos on which participants are recognizable and certainly not by taking photos of the participant photo wall. Please also note that you are **not allowed to take pictures of the posters and presentations** during the Research Meeting on Thursday July 7, 2022 since these are unpublished work of other authors. Please treat them as confidential.

Travel information

By train

From Brussels airport, we would recommend taking a train to Leuven, as they are frequent and quick (usually quicker than a taxi, due to traffic). The train station at the Airport is located on level -1 and can be easily reached by using the escalators or elevators.



Once you have arrived in Leuven, you will quickly notice that the city is rather small and that everything can easily be reached **on foot**. It is a 15-minute walk from Leuven station (*Martelarenplein 16, Leuven*) to the Maria-Theresiacollege (*Sint-Michielsstraat 6, Leuven*): see <u>directions</u> or scan the QR-code.



If you don't feel like walking, you can also take **the bus**. A lot of buses run through the city centre: Bus number 2 takes you to bus stop 'Sint-Michielskerk', only 50 meters from the conference venue (e.g.: De Lijn).

If you need a taxi, you can take one at the entrance of the Leuven railway station or book a taxi by telephone via +32 16 22 20 00 (Taxi Leuven) or +32 16 26 10 10 (Taxi Jenny). Please note that there are no Ubers in Leuven! If you are at the conference venue and need a taxi, please come and see us at the registration desk, and we will book one for you.

By car

Leuven is located at the junction of two motorways: the E40 and the E314. The 'P' signposts will guide you to the different car parks. An overview of the car parks in Leuven can be found <u>here</u>.

There is **no parking** at the conference venue (except for wheelchair users – please contact <u>cystinosis2022@kuleuven.be</u> for more information). You can find **the nearest public parking** at <u>Q-Park</u> <u>Heilig Hart</u> (address: *Naamsestraat 102, 3000 Leuven, Belgium*). From here it is only a 7-minute walk (550m) to the conference venue: <u>https://goo.gl/maps/PW1DWq5bUuFFt1YT9</u>.

There is another public parking under the <u>Monseigneur Ladeuzeplein</u>, which is also a 6-minute walk to the conference venue: <u>https://goo.gl/maps/47VYn3cwtRkqfNnn7</u>.



COVID-19 measures

General COVID-19 measures

As of March 23, we can organize the meeting in person with no restrictions.

A Covid-19 certificate is no longer needed to enter the congress venues. Face masks are no longer mandatory in public transport, in the congress venues and restaurants/bars/shops in the city. A Passenger Locator Form (PLF) is no longer needed within the EU.

As you are aware, many people with cystinosis have had kidney transplants and will be immunosuppressed. We would ask that you keep this in mind. While mask wearing is not mandatory in Belgium as mentioned above, out of respect to people in our community who may feel safer, we welcome and recommend mask wearing while indoors at conference sessions.

Travelling to Belgium

The Passenger Locator Form (PFL) must be filled in *by everyone who, directly or indirectly, travels to Belgium from a country OUTSIDE the European Union or Schengen area that is not on the white list* (which you can find <u>here</u>), by train, bus, boat or plane. The PLF document can be found <u>here</u> and must be filled in maximum 48h prior to your arrival in Belgium. In all other cases, you may fill in the PLF, but it is not mandatory.

If you need to take a COVID-19 PCR test in Belgium, please find below an overview of the test centers.

- PCR-travel or -event testing without CTPC testing in private test centres
 - o <u>Brussels Airport</u>: €67
- PCR-travel or -event testing in public test centres with CTPC (Covid Test Prescription Code): €50
 - **step 1**: create your CTPC. This can only be done by yourself. Your GP or the test centre can't assist you on this.
 - <u>nonresidents or those without electronic access to their online personal health</u> platform
 - o step 2: book your <u>online appointment</u>
 - mark that you have a CTPC, that you request a travel or event test appointment and that you don't have symptoms
 - select a test centre near the conference venue (Heilig Hart Hospital Leuven, Naamsestraat 105, 3000 Leuven), give your CTPC and book your appointment
 - o step 3: get tested
 - o **step 4**: receive your test result
 - in your <u>online personal health platform</u> under "mijn testresultaten*"
 - via your <u>CTPC</u> and 4 last digits of your mobile number
 - in your <u>EU COVID Health Certificate</u>

For a COVID certified antigen test, you can go to one of the pharmacies in the city centre: e.g. Apotheek Vanschoenwinkel (Diestsestraat 129, 3000 Leuven / +32 16 22 31 12) or Apotheek Vandenbosch (Brusselsestraat 136, 3000 Leuven / +32 16 22 15 30). Please note that making an appointment is required. You can find the opening hours of both pharmacies online.

Registration

Registration and Information Desk

The **Registration and Information Desk** is situated in room 00.03 of the Maria-Theresiacollege (*Sint-Michielsstraat 6, Leuven*). Please follow the signage upon arrival at the venue.





When you arrive for the first time on the conference venue, you can pick up your **conference badge** at the Registration and Information Desk. Please note that it can be quite busy at the desk on Thursday evening and Friday morning. So, to avoid long queues, we strongly advise you to pick up your badge in time.



Conference badges

All registered participants will be given a name badge upon registration at the registration desk. This badge is your official pass to the conference venue and the social activities. We kindly request you to wear your badge visibly on all conference occasions.

<u>Wi-Fi</u>

We offer free Wi-Fi in all university buildings. The network to connect with is **campusroam**. Each participant will receive a **personal login name and password**. These personal login details can be found on the back of your name badge. Please note that these login details can only be used at one device at a time. Once you enter your login and password, you should be able to access the campusroam network.

Should you have an **eduroam**-account, you will be able to access the eduroam-network as well within the university buildings.

AUTOMATIC CONFIGURATION WITH THE CAT-TOOL

Should you experience any problems, we advise you to use the CAT-tool to automatically configure the wireless networks campusroam and eduroam.

Download the tool from <u>cat.eduroam.org</u> or scan the QR-code to the right. The tool does the complete configuration from scratch or adjusts existing configurations for pc, smartphone and tablet.
